GPD seeks to build peace and foster democracy and good governance at the community, local, state and national levels to catalyze sustainable development. Our core Programme areas include Conflict Prevention and Peacebuilding, Democracy and Governance, Environment and Community Health, Gender Equality, and Sustainable Development. Global Peace Development works in seven States within Nigeria (Delta, Edo, Cross River, Rivers, Adamawa, Kaduna, and Nasarawa).

Environment and Wash Officer- Delta and Taraba States

The primary purpose of this position is to provide direct oversight for the Water, Hygiene and Sanitation (WASH) portfolio. The WASH Officer is expected to guide, coordinate, manage and monitor the expanding water, sanitation and hygiene related activities in the state. The incumbent will fulfil a range of oversight responsibilities; include technical leadership, as well as effective and efficient oversight and monitoring to ensure program performance, objectives and results are achieved in accordance to work plans.

Required Qualification and Experience

Education: A Bachelor's degree in Public Health, Water and Sanitation, Environmental Science, or Environmental Engineering is required.

Technical SKILLS and EXPERIENCE

- Knowledge on WASH related programming with at least 2 years of progressive experience will be giving priority consideration
- Essential: basic training in WASH programming
- Essential: at least 1 years programming experience with NGO in Nigeria

- Essential: good understanding of WASH policies and strategies, and programmes
- Essential: very good understanding of safe water and hygiene practice in Nigeria will be added advantage
- Desirable: Experience in community based interventions in Nigeria
- Desirable: analytical & research skills, experience in conducting health systems research, ability to analyse data using SPS

Major Roles and Responsibilities;

- Work closely with the Programme Coordinator; Environment and community health to ensure that deliverables across GPD states are met
- Support desk reviews, community needs assessments where necessary and develop briefing notes on WASH, TB, Malaria and Environmental Issues in GPD States
- Develop community based project concepts to address local needs around Environment and Community Health
- Support the implementation of Environment and Health related projects in a timely and professional manner, according to established objectives, outputs and indicators and in line with donor requirements and beneficiary needs
- Support technical designs, development of budgets, technical specifications and documentation for all WASH and Community Health Programme activities
- Ensure the timely submission of information for internal and donor reports for all program activities, including reporting against the logical framework
