The ideal candidate would oversee program implementation, staff management, and partnership with the citizenry, government and donor community

- Engage relevant stakeholders on policy advocacy and partnerships
- Manage state office personnel and performance appraisal
- Provide oversight of the implementation of projects
- Support development of PRA, Needs Assessment, conflict mapping and analysis
- Review programme and research reports
- Develop advocacy and policy briefs for stakeholder engagement
- Ensure staff compliance with organizational policies
- Document and share state monthly report including beneficiary feedback
