Job Title and Location: Agricultural Extension Officer, Yobe North, Yobe South, and Yobe East Senatorial Districts

Position Summary

The Agricultural Extension Officer will support the implementation of climatesmart agricultural practices, facilitate farmer capacity-building, and provide continuous technical advisory services to beneficiary communities. The role will be based in one of the three senatorial districts and will require frequent field visits.

Key Responsibilities

- Mobilize and support farmers to adopt sustainable and climate-resilient farming methods.
- Conduct field level training, and capacity building sessions for smallholder farmers.
- Promote agroforestry, soil conservation, and water use efficiency practices.
- Assist in monitoring livestock performance and provide technical backstopping.
- Collect and report field data including success stories, farmer feedback, and progress updates.
- Work closely with State ACReSAL teams, and community based structures (CIGs, CRFs, and Site Committee)
- Ensure proper documentation, attendance, and reporting of field activities.

Qualifications and Experience

- BSc/HND in Agricultural Extension, Agronomy, Crop Science, Animal Science, or related field
- At least 5 years of field experience in agricultural extension, climate-resilient agriculture, environment, or livelihood programming.
- Familiarity with rural communities and farming practices in Yobe State.
- Applicant must reside in any of the three senatorial districts
- Applicant should be fluent in Kanuri, Hausa and/or local languages spoken in the assigned senatorial district is required.
